
Figure 1. "Advisory Group" retrieved from https://webixi.com/2017/12/28/nonprofit-advisory-group/



- Gochiso currently displays electronic holdings, could be modified to also display print holdings





Your item TT922 .F7 1998 is shelved on Floor 4, Stack 54



- Leverages OneButton
- When an item is held and available, call number (from availability API) is searched in delimited table

For example, for call number TT922.F7 1998, the call number (normalized) matches the range indicated in this table entry:

f4|TL 671.2 .A3735 1988|TX 501 .R47|454|Floor 4, Stack 54

The delimited table must have an entry for every shelf unit (if the shelf map is to show that level of detail).

When match is found in table, user is shown a map image with jQuery image hotspots mapped to highlight specific stack locations

Shelf maps are in the process of being deployed in production at PALNI. The code is based on a project developed at California State University, Northridge to work with the III Innovative System.


